## HUE \& ME TOBOGGAN BEANIES

## EASY

## WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- 'Lion Brand' Hue + Me 125g, I skein each Col A Spicy, Col B Sea Glass, Col C Bellini
- Size 6.5 m circular knitting needles, 40 cm long and 6.5 m double pointed knitting needles.
- Stitch marker.
- Scissors, yarn needle, tape measure.
- Large 8cm pompom maker.

## TENSION

12 sts +14 rows $=10 \mathrm{~cm}$ in stockinette in the round.

Pattern Notes - Hat is worked from the bottom up on circular needles and then finished on double pointed needles for the crown shaping. Opposite colour is stranded behind work on rounds with more than one colour. Keep floats very loose to ensure hat can still stretch. Pattern is written for three sizes: child (adult small, adult large). Up to three adult large hats can be made with one skein of each colour if alternating colours. Designate a colour A, B, and C before beginning.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Bottom Edging:

With colour A and circular needles, cast on $48(54,60)$. Join in the round, being careful not to twist sts. Place marker for beginning of rib round.

Rounds 1-6 (7, 8): *K 1, P 1, rep from * around.

Body:
Change to colours B and C. Round numbers will restart for simplicity. Begin chart, working in stranded stockinette (knitting every round), at bottom right corner, round 1. All rounds are read right to left on the chart. Work chart through round $13(14,15)$.

## Crown shaping:

Change to double pointed needles when necessary.

## Child size only:

Round 14: Continuing with colour C, *K 6, K2tog, rep from * to end of round. (42 sts)

Round 15: K.
Round 16: *K 5, K2tog, rep from * to end of round. (36 sts)
Round 17: K.
Round 18: *K 4, K2tog, rep from * to end of round. (30 sts)

Round 19: K.
Round 20: *K 3, K2tog, rep from * to end of round. (24 sts)

Round 21: K.
Round 22: *K 2, K2tog, rep from * to end of round. (18 sts)
Round 23: K.
Round 24: *K 1, K2tog, rep from * to end of round. (12 sts)

## Adult small size only:

Round 15: Continuing with colour $\mathrm{C}, \mathrm{K}$.
Round 16: *K 7, K2tog, rep from * to end of round. (48 sts)

Round 17: K.
Round 18: *K 6, K2tog, rep from * to end of round. (42 sts)

Round 19: K.
Round 20: *K 5, K2tog, rep from * to end of round. (36 sts)

Round 21: K.
Round 22: *K 4, K2tog, rep from * to end of round. (30 sts)

Round 23: K.
Round 24: *K 3, K2tog, rep from * to end of round. (24 sts)
Round 25: K.
Round 26: *K 2, K2tog, rep from * to end of round. (18 sts)

## Adult large size only:

Rounds 16+17: Continuing with colour C, K.
Round 18: *K 8, K2tog, rep from * to end of round. (54 sts)

Round 19: K.
Round 20: *K 7, K2tog, rep from * to end of round. (48 sts)

Round 21: K. Round 22: *K 6, K2tog, rep from * to end of round. (42 sts)

Round 23: K. Round 24: *K 5, K2tog, rep from * to end of round. (36 sts)

Round 25: K.
Round 26: *K 4, K2tog, rep from * to end of round. (30 sts)

Round 27: K.
Round 28: *K 3, K2tog, rep from * to end of round. (24 sts)

## All sizes:

Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through remaining sts, removing them from the needles. Pull like a drawstring to close hole at top of hat. Secure on interior of hat and weave in all ends.

## Pompom:

With colour A, use pompom maker to make pompom, wrapping yarn approx. 90 times around. Pompom should weigh approx. 14g to ensure three hats can be made from three alternating colours.

(A) Circumference: $40.5(46,51) \mathrm{cm}$
(B) Height: $21.5(24,26) \mathrm{cm}$
