NAVY FLOWER FASCINATOR



INTERMEDIATE

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- · 1 x Maria George Large Flower Navy
- 2 x Maria George Navy Basic Millinery Flower
- · 1 x Maria George Paper Base Navy
- 1 x Maria George Satin Covered Headband, Navy
- 1 x Maria George Feather Flower Crin Fascinator, Navy
- · Needle and thread
- · Navy fabric
- Scissors
- · Shamrock Craft Decofoam Lady Head

INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1 – Carefully take apart the feather flower crin fascinator so you end up with 2 pieces of crin. Disregard the rest of the fascinator.

Step 2 - Carefully take off the paper base from the navy fascinator. Place the head band on the head form and reposition the paper base to the middle of the headband so the scooped part is at the back. Stitch in place using a needle and thread. At this point it's best to try it on your own head to ensure the balance of the weight is right and the fascinator won't fall off. Readjust the positioning of the paper base if needed.

Step 3 - Working with one piece of crin at a time, stitch it in place onto the paper base, around the edge, to create a halo of crin around the face. Repeat with the second piece of crin for a double layer effect. You don't need to be too neat as the flower will cover the stitches.

Step 4 - Now it's time to create the oversized flower. From the navy fabric cut out different sized petal shapes and add them to the outside of the large flower to make it even bigger. Continue adding the smaller petals in amongst the original flower petals and attach with hot glue or stitch in place.

Step 5 – Cut the petals off the 2 x basic millinery flowers and use those petals to fill in any gaps and again attach with hot glue or stitch in place.

Step 6 - To finish attach the flower to the top of your paper base, hiding any of the crin raw edges. Hot glue or stitch in place to secure.
