

# THE WIND CRIES MERINO UNISEX JUMPER

# e EASY

#### WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- 'Abbey Road' The Wind Cries Merino 25g x 12 (13-14-15) balls.
- 1 pair 4.50mm knitting needles or size required to give correct tension.
- Scissors, yarn needle, tape measure

#### **TENSION**

22 sts and 34 rows to 10cm over patt, using 4.50mm needles.

# **INSTRUCTIONS**

# **BACK AND FRONT** (both alike)

Using 4.50mm needles, cast on 111 (123-135-143) sts.

**Beg Rib - 1st row** (RS) - K2, \* P1, K1, rep from \* to last st. K1.

**2nd row** - K1, \* P1, K1, rep from \* to end.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows until work measures 6cm from beg, ending with a 2nd row.

Beg Patt - 1st row (RS) - Knit.

**2nd row** - K3, \* P1, K3, rep from \* to end.

Last 2 rows form patt throughout.

Cont in patt until work measures 43cm from beg, ending with a 2nd row.

**Shape Armholes** – Keeping patt correct, cast off 7 (9-11-12) sts at beg of next 2 rows

... 97 (105-113-119) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next row, then in every foll alt row until 85 (87-93-97) sts rem.

Cont in patt without shaping until armholes measure 19 (20-21-22) cm, working last row on WS.

**Shape Neck - Next row** (RS) - K32 (32-34-34), cast off next 21 (23-25-29) sts loosely, knit to end.

\*\* Cont on these 32 (32-34-34) sts and dec one st at neck edge in every row until 28 (28-30-30) sts rem, then in every foll alt row until 25 (25-27-27) sts rem, then in foll 4th row once ... 24 (24-26-26) sts.

Work 2 rows.

**Shape Shoulder** – Cast off 8 (8-9-9) sts at beg of next row and foll alt row.

Work 1 row. Cast off rem 8 sts. \*\*

With WS facing, join yarn to rem sts and rep from \*\* to \*\*, working 1 row less before shoulder shaping.

#### **SLEEVES**

Using 4.50mm needles, cast on 55 (55-59-59) sts.

**Beg Rib** - Work in rib as for lower band of Back until work measures 6cm from beg, ending with a 2nd row.

**Beg Patt** - Work in patt as for Back and Front, working extra sts into patt, inc one st at each end of 5th row, then in every foll 8th (6th-6th-4th) row until there are 77 (65-93-67) sts, then in every foll 10th (8th-8th-6th) row until there are 85 (89-99-103) sts.

Cont in patt without shaping until work measures 48cm from beg, working last row on WS.

**Shape Top** - Keeping patt correct, cast off 4 (5-6-6) sts at beg of next 2 rows ... 77 (79-87-91) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next row, then in every foll 4th (4th-alt-alt) row until 69 (71-27-29) sts rem, sizes S and M only - then in



every foll alt row until 27 sts rem.

All Sizes - Work 1 row. Cast off rem sts loosely.

### **NECKBAND**

Using mattress st, join right shoulder seam. With RS facing and using 4.50mm needles, knit up 14 sts evenly along left front neck, 20 (22-24-28) sts across cast off sts, 14 sts along right front neck, 14 sts along right back neck, 21 (23-25-29) sts across cast off sts, then 14 sts along left back neck ... 97 (101-105-113) sts.

Work in rib as for lower band of Back and Front (beg with a 2nd row) until neckband measures 3cm, ending with a 2nd row.

Cast off loosely in rib.

#### **FINISHING**

DO NOT PRESS. Join left shoulder and neckband seam. Join side and sleeve seams. Sew in sleeves.
