## WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Sizzix® Big Shot® Machine (660200) or Sizzix® Big Shot® Plus Machine (660020) or Sizzix® Big Shot® Express Machine (660850) or Sizzix® Big Shot® Foldaway Machine (662220)
- Sizzix® 3-D Textured Impressions® Embossing Folder - Doily (80504515/662265)
- Pom Pom Maker
- Glue Gun
- Paper Sculpting tool
- Card (Grey)
- Yarn (Mint)
- Wooden bead
- Corner cutter
- Water spritzer

## INSTRUCTIONS

**Step 1** - Cut two rectangular pieces of gray card.

**Step 2** - Lightly spritz both pieces of card and emboss using the Doily embossing folder.

**Step 3** - Cut the corners of the card to create rounded corners.

**Step 4** - Using mint yarn and the small pom-pom maker, create your pom-pom and tie an additional piece of yarn around the centre.

**Step 5** - Trim your pom-pom with scissors.

**Step 6** - Thread through a wooden bead on the hanging piece of yarn.

**Step 7** - Line up the rectangles back to back and glue together, with the pom-pom loop in the middle of the card.
