

FLINDERS JUMPER

e EASY

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- · '4 Seasons' Flinders and Flinders Prints Cotton 8ply 50g 2, 3, 3, 3 balls Main Colour (M) 4. 5. 5. 6 balls 1st Contrast (C1). 3. 3. 3, 4, balls 2nd Contrast (C2), 2, 2, 3, 3, balls 3rd Contrast (C3), 2, 2, 3, 3, balls 4th Contrast (C4)
- · 1 pair each of 4.00mm knitting needles or size required to give correct tension
- · Scissors, varn needle, tape measure

TENSION

22 sts x 29 rows to 10cm over purl fabric st. using 4.00mm needles

INSTRUCTIONS

BACK

Using 4.00mm needles and M, cast on 122 (134-144-156) sts

Work 32 rows purl fabric

Using C1, work 32 rows purl fabric

Using C2, work 32 rows purl fabric

Using C3, work 32 rows purl fabric

Tie a coloured thread at each end of last row to mark beg of armholes, as there is no armhole shaping**

Using C1, work 32 rows purl fabric

Using C4 for rem, work 32 (36-38-42) purl fabric

SHAPE SHOULDERS

Cast off 9 (11-12-13) sts at beg of next 4 rows. then 10 (10-12-14) sts at beg of foll 2 rows

Cast off rem 66 (70-72-76) sts

FRONT

Work as given for Back to ** Using C1, cont as follows -

DIVIDE FOR NECK OPENING

1st row - P48 (53-57-62), cast off next 26 (28-30-32) sts, purl to end

Cont on last 48 (53-57-62) sts for right side of neck shaping

Dec one st at neck edge in foll alt rows until 39 (44-49-54) sts rem, then in every foll 4th row until 36 (41-46-51) sts rem

Work 1 (1-3-3) rows purl fabric

Using C4 for rem, dec one st at neck edge in 3rd (3rd-next-next) row, then in every foll 4th row until 28 (32-36-40) sts rem

Work 2 rows

SHAPE SHOULDER

Cast off 9 (11-12-13) sts at beg of next and foll alt row

Knit 1 row

Cast off rem 10 (10-12-14) sts

With WS facing, join yarn to rem 48 (53-57-62) sts. knit to end

Cont on these 48 (53-57-62) sts for left side of neck shaping

Dec one st at neck edge in next and foll alt rows until 39 (44-49-54) sts rem. then in every foll 4th row until 36 (41-46-51) sts rem.

Work 1 (1-3-3) rows purl fabric

Using C4 for rem, dec one st at neck edge in 3rd (3rd-next-next) row, then in every foll 4th row until 28 (32-36-40) sts rem

Work 1 row

SHAPE SHOULDER

Cast off 9 (11-12-13) sts at beg of next and foll alt row

Purl 1 row

Cast off rem 10 (10-12-14) sts

SLEEVES

Using 4.00mm needles and M, cast on 60 (62-64-66) sts



Work 32 rows purl fabric, inc one st at each end of 13th row, then in every foll 6th (4th-4th-4th) row ... 68 (72-74-76) sts

Using C1, work 32 rows purl fabric, inc one st at each end of 5th (next-next-next) row, then in every foll 6th (4th-4th-4th) row 5 (5-8-8) times in all, Size M Only then in every foll 6th row twice

All Sizes ... 78 (86-90-92) sts

Using C2, work 32 rows purl fabric, inc one st at each end of 3rd (3rd-next-next) row, then in every foll 6th (6th-4th-4th) row 5 (5-2-5) times in all, Size L and XL Only - then in every foll 6th row (4-2) times

All Sizes ... 88 (96-102-106) sts

Using C3 and purl fabric for rem, inc one st at each end of 3rd (next-3rd-3rd) row, then in every foll 8th (6th-6th-6th) row until there are 92 (102-108-112) sts

Cont without further inc until work measures 41 (42-43-44) cm from beg, working last row on wrong side

SHAPE TOP

Cast off 12 (14-14-15) sts at beg of next 4 rows, then 13 (13-15-14) sts at beg of foll 2 rows.

Cast off rem 18 (20-22-24) sts

NECKBAND

Using mattress st, join shoulder seams. With RS facing, using 4.00mm needles and C1, beg at right front neck shaping, knit up 55 (59-63-67) sts evenly along right side of front neck shaping, knit up 67 (69-71-73) sts evenly across back neck, then knit up 55 (59-63-67) sts along left side of front neck shaping to cast off sts ... 177 (187-197-207) sts

1st row (WS) - P2, * K3, P2, rep from * to end

2nd row (RS) – K2, * P3, K2, rep from * to end

Rep last 2 rows 5 times, then 1st row once

14th row - K2, * P3, K2, P2tog, P1, K2, rep from * to last 5 sts, P3, K2 ... 160 (169-178-187) sts

15th row - P2, * K3, P2, K2, P2, rep from * to last 5 sts, K3, P2

16th row - K2, * P3, K2, P2, K2, rep from * to last 5 sts, P3, K2

Rep last rows 4 times, then 2nd row once

26th row - K2, * P2tog, P1, K2, P2, K2, rep from * to last 5 sts, P2tog, P1, K2 ... 142 (150-158-166) sts

27th row - P2, * K2, P2, rep from * to end.

28th row - K2, * P2, K2, rep from * to end.

Rep last rows 3 (4-5-6) times, then 2nd row once

Cast off very loosely in rib

FINISHING

Placing centre of sleeve to shoulder seam, sew in sleeves evenly between markers. Join side and sleeve seams. Sew down side edge of collar to cast off edge at centre front with left side over right side as pictured. Sew in ends
